## Minutes of the Meeting dated Tuesday, 14<sup>th</sup> March 2017

61. The Chair welcomed everybody to the meeting and asked if there were any interests to declare. None declared
62. Apologies had been received from Cllr Barry Goodey (holiday) & Cllr Dudley Hughes (ENC) and were duly accepted by the Council.
63. Mr Croft asked to Council to justify the increase in precept which it did and he left with a greater understanding of what the Council pays for from its precept.
64. The Co-option did not take place as further information was required from the Monitoring Officer, ENC.
65. The arrangements for the new clerk were discussed and it was noted that advertisements for the position would be appearing shortly.
66. Minutes of the previous meeting dated 10<sup>th</sup> January 2017 were **proposed, agreed** and duly signed by the Chair, as a true reflection of the meeting.
67. **Planning** – 16/02305/FUL Proposal: Residential development of 11No dwellings and associated infrastructure including new highway access at Land Adjacent Meadowview OP1990 SP9673 Woodford Road Little Addington Northamptonshire (PP-05651830). ENC had confirmed that a Committee date had not been set.  
17/00334/FUL 5 Watervill Way – 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Extension – Following discussion, no objections raised  
17/00464/TPO Rear of Industrial Park, Irthlingborough Road – Following discussion, no objections raised  
Planning Application 16/02119/FUL Warehousing at Raunds – The Council had received an email from Barbara Hunt in Great Addington – PD to contact ENC as it was felt that the Council should make representation regarding this further development.
68. **Highways**  
a) Cllr Dollimore reported from the JAG meeting that the police had been taking speed surveys along the main road and that there was consensus for a 40mph speed limit rather than the changing limits at present and he was pressing for the footpath between the villages to be repaired properly  
b) Cllr Dollimore reported that Sarah Barnwell felt the road was too narrow to have gates. PD to provide more information to back the proposal
69. **Police** – Cllr Dollimore reported that issues in Irthlingborough were paramount at present but he was able to report on the recent issue in Little Addington which was noted by the Council
70. **Financial** - In accordance with the Standing Orders and Financial Regulations, the Financial Report & Bank Reconciliation for last month were considered, it was **proposed and duly resolved** that they should be accepted by the Council. The Clerk was authorised to make the payments following the signing of each invoice by 2 signatories.
